### *Fur Traders*

*Curriculum Connections: History, New France*



Students played the role of “Coureurs de Bois” in the **Fur Traders** activity. Teams had to find their way along river trading routes to gain knowledge on First Nations food, medicine, technology and the fur trade. They traded the furs they earned with the French Traders at the Trading Post for supplies to survive in New France during the 1600’s.

For **Survival Skills**, students were given a situation in which they needed to build a shelter out of fallen logs. They worked in teams to effectively use the available resources. They also learned to build a fire, which they used to cook bannock, a type of bread that First Nations People made.
